	ADVANCED PLACEMENT	DUAL ENROLLMENT
<b>Curriculum based on</b>	Standard AP course	College course
<b>School level of course</b>	High school (advanced)	College
<b>Credit earned based on</b>	AP exam score	Passing course
<b>Do colleges accept credit?</b>	Varies by school, usually a score of 3 or higher is required	Varies by school (may be more difficult for out-of-state or private colleges)
<b>Documentation needed for credit?</b>	College Board AP score report	Official college transcript
<b>Is a grade assigned when the credit is transferred (does it affect college GPA)?</b>	No grade or affect on college GPA	Yes for both
<b>How will it affect my high school GPA?</b>	1.08 weighted on High School GPA	1.04 weighted on High School GPA
<b>Can my parents see my progress?</b>	Parents can check progress	Parents may or may not be able to check progress (FERPA)
<b>What is the cost?</b>	Exam fee (\$94.00 per test unless free or reduced lunch)	College Tuition (Approx. \$450-\$520 per 3 hour course)
