

WALDEN MIDDLE SCHOOL'S NEW DAILY SCHEDULE

NEW START AND END TIMES FOR WALDEN STUDENTS

During the Park Hill School Board Meeting on June 22, 2023, the board voted unanimously to revise the start and end times for Walden Middle

School and a few other Park Hill Schools to help mitigate the impact of the bus driver shortage.

Student IDs

Student School IDs are here and as in the past, all students will receive and be required to wear a Park Hill School District issued ID along with a special team lanyard in their team colors. This ID is one of our first lines of school safety. It provides a way for school personnel to identify a student as a Jaguar and if they are where they are supposed to be in the



building. Additionally, students will need to scan their IDs to get on and off the bus which allows us to ensure they are on the correct bus and get off at the correct stop, allows them an easy way to pay for lunch by simply scanning their badge, it is used to check out library books, and earn PBIS rewards.



If a student damages or loses their badge, we will replace it once at no cost. Additional replacement badges are \$5.00. Lost lanyards are \$2.50. Students may not bring a lanyard from home to wear as our lanyards are color specific to their team. IDs must be free of stickers and other items that block a student's photo.

Please reinforce with your student the importance of wearing their ID. We appreciate your help!

Student Technology Distribution

All students new to Walden Middle School, including our 6th graders, will receive their district issued laptops on Tuesday, August 22nd. Any returning students who left their laptop on campus during the summer can visit the technology office to pick up their laptop.

TRANSPORTATION CHANGES

Bus Riders: <u>BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR INFINITE CAMPUS FOR YOUR</u>
BUS TIME AND BUS NUMBER.



In June, PHSD adjusted the bus transportation boundaries to help alleviate the shortage of bus drivers in Park Hill School District. This adjustment includes only offering bus transportation to students living within a defined distance from their school. For the 2023-2024 school year, the Park Hill School District will provide transportation services to middle school students who live beyond 1.0 mile from their school.


* Students should not be dropped off or picked up in the parking lot. This is unsafe. Please make your way to the sidewalks near the building. *

Student Afternoon Pick Up

In order to ensure the safety and to expedite the pick up process after school, students pick up areas are in separate areas of the campus. The map below highlights the pickup locations.

- Grade 8 students will be picked up behind the school Enter off N. Northwood.
- Grade 7 will be picked up in front of the school Enter off NW 56th Street.
- Grade 6 will be picked up on the west end of the building by the basketball courts Enter off NW 56th Street.


