FISD Henry Winston Stadium Rules and Regulations

Home Football Games: Aug. 25, Sept. 1, Sept. 8, Oct. 6 and Oct. 20

General Facility:

- Gates will open one hour prior to game time.
- No Firearms allowed.
- State laws and school district policies prohibit the use of tobacco products in any form, alcoholic beverages, and controlled substances on school district property. • No loitering will be permitted. Spectators must sit in the stands and keep off the rails. Aisles should be kept clear at all times. Spectators may not cross to the other side of the stadium.
- All elementary and intermediate students must be accompanied by an adult.
- No horseplay of any kind.
- No pets allowed except for service animals.
- No outside food or drink may be brought into the stadium; this does not apply to band, drill team, or cheerleaders.
- Bags, backpacks, coolers, etc., are not allowed in the stadium; however, this does not apply to band, drill team, or cheerleaders. All persons are subject to search at any time.
- Purses are allowed but may be subject to search at any time.
- Items such as Frisbees, balls, whistles, etc., are not allowed in the stadium.
- Glass bottles/containers are prohibited in the stadium and parking lot. • No pyrotechnics can be used in the facility.
- Tailgating must be approved by Administration, High School Principal and Athletic Department. Tailgaters will be given an assigned area by athletics. No open flames will be allowed.
- Food, drinks, gum, sunflower seeds and tobacco are prohibited at all times around or on the field areas.
- Only emergency vehicles, broadcasters, approved media may be parked inside of the stadium.
- Only authorized personnel will be allowed on the field or in the field house area before the game, at halftime. Individuals on the field or surrounding area must present a sideline pass issued by the Athletic Department. Passes must be picked up from the Athletics Department no later than 12:00 noon on Thursday prior to Friday's game.
- No merchandise will be sold at the stadium unless approved by Administration, High School Principal, Assistant Athletic Director, and the Athletic Department.

Stadium Emergency Management/Evacuation Plan

- In the event of an Emergency, the FPD senior ranking officer in charge will coordinate with the Executive Director of Safety and Operations or Principal/Assistant Principal.
- Stadium broadcaster, voice of the Mustangs will communicate all Emergency and Safety related announcements via the stadium sound system.
- In the event of severe weather all staff, athletes and spectators will be required to evacuate the stadium. Spectators may evacuate to their vehicle or choose to shelter in a designated evacuation location as follows:

FHS Football Team, Coaches and Officials:	Report to the Field House through exterior door #16
FHS Wranglerettes, Band and Color Guard:	Report dance room 101 and 102 through exterior door #30
FHS Choir and Cheer:	Report to World Language classrooms through door #27
Home Side fans:	Report to vehicles or report to Math/Science building through double doors #27 and go into the freshman mall.
Visitor Side fans:	Report to vehicles or to the cafeteria.
Visiting Cheer, Dance team, Band/Other Groups:	Report to the cafeteria
Visiting Football and staff:	Report to the Visitor locker room

❖ Event Staff, Administrators and Police/Fire Dept. will direct patrons to the evacuation locations.

Stadium Seating

- Home Side Seating Sections are as follows:

Section A: Band and Wranglerettes Only

Section B: General Admission

Section C: Rows 1-16 General Admission, 17-31 Reserved

Section D: Reserved

Section E: Rows 1-16 - General Admission, 17-31 Reserved

Section F: General Admission

Section G: Student Section and General Admission

Parking/Shuttle Locations

- Reserved Parking is in the Junior Lot (Directly behind the home side grandstands), Must have Friendswood Football Parking Tag to park in this lot.
- Natatorium Lot, Senior Lot, and Teacher Lots are open for general parking.
- There will be NO parking on any FISD grass fields at the FHS campus.
- Additional shuttle runs will be made from the below mentioned areas to FHS.
- Parking is available at Friendswood Junior High and Bales Intermediate with shuttle service to and from the stadium. Shuttles start at 5:30 PM and run until 1 hour after the event. Shuttles will run to FHS and drop off near the stadium and pick-up at the Natatorium parking lot.
