

AM Arrival


- Doors will open at 7:05
- Doors will be locked and alarms activated at 7:25




PM Dismissal

Reporting to School / Class

- 1. **DOORS** Open at 7:05 each day
- 2. **BREAKFAST** will be available in the cafeteria before school
- 3. REPORT TO THE CAFE PRIOR TO 7:15
- 4. WARNING BELL: 7:15
- 5. TARDY BELL: 7:25 (Students in seat)

Ohio State Law: House Bill 410

HB 410 applies to any time missed from school

(Days/Classes Missed, Tardiness, Early Dismissal, etc)

EXCESSIVE ABSENCES (Excused AND Unexcused)

Upon reaching this hourly threshold, the following will occur:

- 1. The district will notify the student's parents in writing
- 2. The student will follow the district's plan for absence intervention; and
- 3. The student and family may be referred to community resources.

HABITUAL TRUANCY (Unexcused Only)

Upon reaching this hourly threshold, the following will occur:

- 1. The student will be assigned to an absence intervention team.
- 2. The district will develop the student's absence intervention plan.
- 3. If the student does not make progress on the plan within 60 days or continues to be excessively absent, the district may file a complaint in juvenile court.

PSHS Attendance Policies Absences from School / Class (per handbook policy)

- Excused Absences Medical, Court, Pre-Approved School Sponsored Function
- Unexcused Absences from Class
 - Semester Class Limit = 8
 - Year Long Class Limit = 15

Students that exceed the unexcused absence limit for a semester and /or year long class are not permitted to make up missed assignments unless a missed assignment counts for 20% or more of the nine weeks grade.

Policies and Procedures Sign In and Sign Out



TARDY

- Arrival after 7:25 am
 - Doors locked at 7:25 am
 - Late students must enter through B4 (Main Office Entrance)
- Tardies are recorded on a per semester basis
- Refer to PSHS Handbook for progressive discipline related to Tardiness

EARLY DISMISSAL

- Parents MUST COMMUNICATE with the Main Office NO LATER
 THAN 9:05 am each day. Parents may:
 - Call Attendance Line
 - Write Detailed and Signed Note (Student will leave in marked box outside of Main Office
- Students will sign out at main office and be dismissed



Library / Media

LIBRARY

- The library may be available before school from 7:05-7:20 to print/as needed
- The library will be available for students to sign in during designated study halls. More information will be shared with students regarding library use throughout the school year.

CHROMEBOOKS

- Chromebooks have been issued to each student
- Students are responsible for daily care of the chromebook assigned to them
 - Bring fully-charged Chromebook to school every day
 - Responsible for damaged or lost Chromebook
 - Refer to your AGREEMENT FORM

LUNCH



- Students will eat lunch in the cafeteria.
- Students are responsible for:
 - Behaving appropriately during lunch or may be asked to eat in a alternate location for a period of time
 - Cleaning up after themselves every day
 - The Food Service Department has the right to refuse "extras" to students with a negative balance

Guidance Department

Include at least 5 Academic classes (absolutely no more than 2 SH daily)

Students attending "Structured Study Hall" should report to assigned room and meet with assigned tutor.

We will correct "EMERGENCY" changes as soon as possible. Sign sheet outside of Guidance Office if balance is a problem. We will email updated schedules.

Guidance Department What We Can't Do:

- We cannot change your schedule to get you a different teacher.
- We cannot change your schedule to get you a different lunch.
- We cannot find you a tutor that will make sure you do your homework.

Add/Drop

- Last day to drop a class without penalty:
 - End of first grading period for a full year course.
 (October 27, 2023)
 - End of first or third grading period for a semester course
- Last day to add a class:
 - End of tenth day of the first grading period for all year/first semester course. (September 7, 2023)
 - End of tenth day of the third grading period for a second semester course.

PSHS Policies and Procedures

Students are encouraged to dress for success!

- Backpacks, large purses/handbags (larger than an 8 ½ x 11" paper) are NOT permitted in hallways or classrooms after 7:25 am
- Torso must be covered.
- Skirts must be 3 inches from top of the knee. (Post-it note length)
- No holes in jeans (No Skin showing)
- Tank tops, halter tops, see through tops or tops with spaghetti straps are **NOT** permitted.
- Hair color (natural tones only)
- Medical verification is needed for accommodations to dress code; student will receive a clinic pass for the day

Policies and Procedures Electronic Communication Devices

School Issued Chromebook

- Bring Chromebook fully charged EVERY MORNING
- Student is responsible for condition of Chromebook at ALL TIMES
 - Bar code and IP address are linked to the student assigned to the Chromebook
- Students must follow all PSHS Technology Usage Policies both in and out of school while using the device
- Chromebooks will be collected by the school at the end of each year. Any damage to the device will be the responsibility of the student

Policies and Procedures Electronic Devices

Cell Phones and Other Personal Devices

- Cell phones are not permitted from 7:25 2:10
- Bluetooth devices are not permitted (Earbuds, Airpods, etc)
 - Students may plug wired headphones in to a Chromebook with teacher permission

Student Infractions and Disciplinary Action

- First Offense 2 Detentions
- Second Offense 2-Hour Saturday
- Third Offense 4-Hour Saturday
- Additional Offenses could result in Suspension
