As an active reader, it is important for you to monitor your own reading strategies. One of the best strategies to use is generating questions before, during, and after reading. Here are some sample questions to ask yourself:

- Prereading:** What does the title mean?
 What is the selection about?
- During reading:** What is going to happen next?
 Why did the character do that or say that?
- Postreading:** What was the author’s purpose in writing this work?
 What additional information do I need to have?
 What did I learn?
