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Inter-Lakes Middle/High School Senior Privileges

2023-24

When Inter-Lakes Middle/High School students reach senior year, we like to extend the privilege of signing out of the building during a free block. We recognize that senior status is reached by maturing academically, intellectually and socially. Senior privileges provide certain freedoms that reflect growth in independence and responsibility.

What are Senior Privileges?

Any senior who has a free block during their academic day, and is academically eligible, is able to sign out of the building during their free block.

Procedure

Students wishing to use their senior privileges must sign out in the main office. When seniors return to campus they must sign back in upon arrival. **Students must only enter and exit the building through the main entrance.** Seniors must leave the school campus if they have signed out of the building.

Student Obligations/Eligibility for Accepting Senior Privileges

With privileges, comes responsibility. It is expected that students will adhere to all of the following expectations:

1. Seniors must carry at least 3 classes per semester. Any exemptions to this must be approved by the administration.
2. Seniors must be passing all of their current course work and be in good academic and behavioral standing.
3. Students must be maintaining a consistent or often rating on personal competencies.
4. Students may not sign out during academic classes.
5. **Students may NOT sign out during office hours on advisory days.** (If we do not have school on a Monday, the first day of school that week is an advisory day and they must attend OH.)
6. Students that accumulate more than 3 tardies, will lose senior privileges until the end of the current quarter.
7. Students may not transport other students off campus.
8. Violation of these rules will result in suspension of senior privileges. A plan must be made and approved by administration to earn privileges back, once they are suspended.
9. Students must have parental consent to sign out of the building **regardless of age.**
