

SCHOLARSHIP THROUGH SCHOOLINKS

1. Accessing Scholarship Matching

From the dashboard, click the **Finances** icon on the left hand navigation bar and select **Scholarship Matching** from the side menu.

2. Creating a Scholarship Match Profile

Creating a Scholarship Match Profile allows SchoolLinks to match or recommend scholarships that match your eligibility and/or interests.

There are three segments to complete your scholarship match profile on SchoolLinks.

Complete as much of these sections as you can to help increase your matching accuracy:

1. **Eligibility:** your demographic data such as location, GPA, and gender
2. **Interests:** your interests and pursuits
3. **Colleges:** your college interests and goals to help align with college-specific scholarships

Once you've completed each section (or as much as you want to complete), click on **View Matches**.

3. Viewing Results

Your scholarship matches will be given a score from 1-100 based on how well the scholarship matches your profile. By default we sort this list by best to worst matches. You can click on a scholarship to see the specific areas where you matched for this scholarship.

You can apply by clicking **Apply** which will take you to the scholarship application (outside of SchoolLinks). If you did apply for a scholarship, use the **Mark as Applied** button to indicate that you applied for the scholarship. This will help you later in the [College Cost Comparison](#) section as you tabulate your scholarship earnings.
