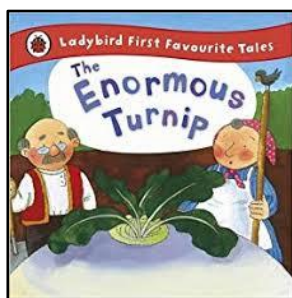
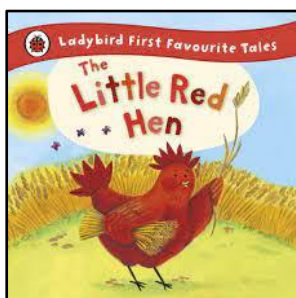
We look forward to working together throughout the year so that the F1 children benefit from strong links between home and Nursery.
