SCHOOL EMERGENCY INFORMATION GUIDE

What Families Should Do

The natural instinct for parents or guardians is to come to the school during an emergency to protect their children. However, by doing so, they may endanger themselves and their children. Law enforcement and school personnel are busy responding to the situation. Your arrival or calls may distract them from their work. Please help by following the steps below.



Stay Home

The most important contribution you can make to your student and your own safety may be staying away from the school.



Stay Informed

Information will be shared with families as soon as possible. Please know, in some situations, accurate information may take some time to verify and share.



Be Ready

Be prepared to follow instructions from the District.

You will be reunited with your child as directed by school or public safety officials. Students will ONLY be released to individuals who are documented as emergency contacts and who present a picture ID.

Safety Terms and Procedures

Modified Lockdown

An emergency response to an actual or potential (non-imminent) threat outside the building; school continues inside the building, all outside activities are discontinued; all exterior doors are locked. No one is allowed in or out of the building. *Examples: animal on grounds or nearby; criminal activity in the area.*

Lockdown

An emergency response to an actual or potential threat inside or outside the building; students and staff will remain in locked classrooms; all exterior doors are locked. No one is allowed in or out of classrooms or the building. Only law enforcement or fire department can override locked doors. *Examples: police emergency, or other hazard near or on school grounds.*

Shelter-in-Place

An emergency response when students and staff may remain inside the building; may need to relocate to a different location within the building and close windows and doors. Examples: extreme weather, chemical spill.

Evacuation

An emergency response when a building needs to be vacated and students and staff moved to a new location. *Examples: fire, chemical spill.*

HOW YOU CAN HELP

- Ensure your child's school has up-todate information (phone, email, and address) for you and <u>ALL</u> emergency contacts. The District's notification system uses this data to contact you.
- Have current Emergency Contact information on your child's record in the event of an unplanned early dismissal.
- Know that District and school administrators and law enforcement are the **only** official source of information in a school emergency.

INFORM YOUR CHILD'S SCHOOL OFFICE OF UPDATED CONTACT INFORMATION!

The Skyward Student Information System is connected to ParentSquare, our parent notification system.

ParentSquare is a system used to communicate important messages via email, app, and/or telephone. These messages can be from the District Office or your child's school, and can include information about school closures due to adverse weather, attendance information, and school news.

TOUCHBASE ONLINE PAYMENTS

Touchbase payment portal works in conjunction with your **Family Access login and password** to allow online payments with VISA and MasterCard debit and credit cards. The website securely accepts payment over the internet any time of the day or night; payments are reflected on the student's account within a few hours of payment. The District does not store credit card information, but past receipts can be reprinted at any time.



If a fine or fee exists on your child's account, a red message will appear. ALL FINES MUST BE PAID before other items can be purchased. This does not apply to Food Service payments.
- To shop for a different student, click on the "Your Family" link at the top of the screen and select the desired student.
- After selecting all purchases, select "Checkout" and follow the prompts.
- Guests/community members can donate to a school, club, or sports team by clicking the "Make a Donation" button on the Touchbase homepage (this does not require a login ID).



Raising children is a tough job. This easy-to-use mobile app allows you to check on the school bus whenever you want.

Set up BusZone:

- 1. Download the BusZone app from the App Store or Google Play.
- 2. Enter the above School Access Code.
- In the search field, enter the bus or route number you want to follow.
 Complete this step for all the buses your students ride throughout the week.
- 4. Enter your child's unique student ID.
- 5. Create alert zones around drop-off and pick-up points.

When your child's bus enters an alert zone, you will receive notification by email or text.

Trust that your information is secure.

Security is priority one, especially where student information is concerned. All parent/ guardian information is locked down and password protected within the app to prevent unauthorized people from opening the app and viewing the child's bus information.

Students: Remember to Ride with Pride!

Pay attention to the Danger Zone. The Danger Zone is the area around the bus. It is hard for the driver to see you when you are in the Danger Zone.

Respect others and the bus. Talk quietly with a friend. Don't throw things inside the bus or out the windows. Keep the bus clean.

Inside, stay seated. Sit facing forward and keep the aisles clear. Keep head, hands, and feet inside the bus.

Don't Run. Running for the bus could cause you to trip or fall.

Exit and move out of the Danger Zone. When you exit the bus, walk away from it. Don't stand near the bus. Don't try to go back on the bus and get anything you left.



Setting A La Carte/Snack Purchase Limits:

Every student is charged the a la carte rate for **any item AFTER their first meal**,

regardless of free or reduced eligibility. If your child chooses any additional items, such as snacks or a second meal portion, they will be charged at the a la carte rate. If you want to put a daily limit on the amount of money that can be spent on snack/a la carte purchases:

• Click **Set Ala Carte Limit**. For each child, you can choose between a dollar amount limit per day, or choose "Do Not Allow Purchase." Then click save. (A value of 0.00 means that a limit is not set.)

How to Apply for School Meal Benefits Online

Food service benefits do not carry over from one school year to the next. A new food service application must be completed at the beginning of each school year.

The application process is quick, confidential, and you can watch the status through your **Skyward Family Access account.**

Login to your <u>Skyward Family Access Account</u> and follow these steps:

- Click "Food Service" on the left-hand side menu.
- Along the top of the page, click the drop-down box next to "All Students" and select a student from your household - you will only need to fill out one application for your household. • Click the "**Applications**" link located along the top of this new page.
- Click the "Add Application" link.
- Follow the prompts to **complete** and **submit** an application.
- IMPORTANT: When entering your electronic signature, be sure that it matches exactly the name you entered in Section 3. For example, if you enter your name with a middle initial, you must include that middle initial in your signature.

... your school-age child may qualify for certain rights and protections under the McKinney-Vento Act. Please complete the attached housing questionnaire and return to your child's school.

A family may find themselves at a point of transition without a home or struggling to meet the daily living needs of their children.

School counselors and school social workers can help with school and community resources.

If you are not sure if your child is eligible, please contact the McKinney-Vento Liaison.

Your eligible child has the right to:

- Receive a free, appropriate public education.
- Enroll in school immediately, even if lacking documents normally required for enrollment.
- Enroll in school and attend classes while the school gathers needed documents.
- Enroll in the local school; or continue attending their school of origin (the school they attended when permanently housed or the school in which they were last enrolled), if that is your preference and is feasible. If the school district believes that the school you select is not in the best interest of your child, then the district must provide you with a written explanation of its position and inform you of your right to appeal its decision.
- Receive transportation to and from school, if you request this.
- Receive educational services comparable to those provided to other students, according to your child's needs.

If you believe your child may be eligible, contact your child's school counselor or the district liaison to find out what services and supports may be available. There also may be supports available for your preschool-age children.
