Boundary Process

- August 16 October 1: Pasco School District stakeholder engagement using the ThoughtExchange platform.
 - Combination of online and in-person engagement
 - Intentional focus on language and technology access
- Opening Question:
 - What is most important to you about how Pasco School District (PSD) makes decisions about boundary revisions for PSD high schools? Why is this important to you?

Boundary Process

- ThoughtExchange Platform has been launched throughout the Pasco School District
 - At this time over 500 participants have contributed their thoughts to this process.
- October 10 Board Report: Present the outcome of ThoughtExchange process and provide an opportunity for Board discussion

Boundary Process: Next Steps

October-November

• Boundary scenarios will be drafted based on the themes and priorities collected from the ThoughtExchange process.

December-February

 Stakeholder meetings to collect input and revise boundary scenarios.

March-April

 District staff will engage Board in decision making process using stakeholder input and data.

High School Naming Process

Timeline

The naming process for High School #3 and the small innovative high school will occur simultaneously.

- August 2: Naming Committee applications
- August 9-21: Thought Exchange available for name suggestions
- August 13: Committee applications close
- August 14-18: committee participants were notified

Next Steps

- Naming Committee meetings
 - August 23
 - September 13
 - September 20 (if needed)
- 3-5 names selected for Board approval



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
