## **Upcoming Important Events**

Students and families are invited to come to school to kick off the 2023-2024 school year. This is an opportunity for students to meet their teachers and get their schedule. Families are welcome to come anytime from 4 PM to 8 PM on Monday, August 28th. *Please be aware that teachers will be in the building at different times.* 

In our gym, there will be multiple opportunities to hear messages from Principal Hyer and Assistant Principal Buttell. They will be in the gym at 5:00pm and 6:30pm. More information will be included in later communications.

#### **Trail Assignments**

- We are expecting students to remain in the trails they have been assigned to for the purpose of keeping balanced trails.
- We understand there are situations that are unique to a student that may result in switching a student to a different trail. These situations are rare and will require discussion with administrators. A change in a trail assignment is not guaranteed.

- Our school day begins at 8:35 am and ends at 3:25 pm
- We will have a new bell schedule.
- We ask that students not arrive at school prior to 8:10 am and leave campus by 3:35 pm
- Doors to the school will open at 8:10 am

#### **Two Hours Early Release**

Two hour early releases will take place on the following dates:

September 20th, 2023. October 11th, 2023. November 8th, 2023. December 13th, 2023. January 10th, 2024. February 14th, 2024. March 13th, 2024. April 17th, 2024. May 15th, 2024.

Your student will start their day at the normal time of 8:35 am and be released at 1:25 pm. They will receive lunch prior to our 1:25 pm dismissal when buses leave the building. Students participating in Varsity Co-curriculars will board the activity bus at 3:25 pm. All other students need to ensure they have transportation home. *Please note that there are no middle school co-curriculars running on early release Wednesdays.* 

#### **School Pictures**

## **Immunizations**

All 7th grade students must have their required immunizations completed <u>before</u> the first day of school, Thursday, September 7th, 2023. ## Free/Reduced Lunch

All students are eligible for one free breakfast and lunch per school day under the new Minnesota Free School Meals legislation. We still highly encourage you to fill out the application for Educational Benefits. Please follow this link for instructions and an application. If you qualify for free or reduced meals your student would be eligible for reduced athletic and activity fees, reduced price internet and more. This also helps with additional teaching and learning funds for DMMS. Extra entrees and cartons of milk will still need to be purchased with money in your lunch account. # Infinite Campus Parent Portal/Census Verification: Must be done to RECEIVE a device

All parents/guardians will need to have a Parent Portal account in Infinite Campus prior to completing necessary back to school paperwork. All of the Dakota Meadows communication, including report cards, will come through the Infinite Campus Portal. The Census Verification MUST be completed in Infinite

<u>Campus in order for students to receive their chromebooks.</u> The Census Verification can be found in the parent portal on the left hand side, there is a blue link located towards the bottom.

## **Device Pickup**

Chromebooks will be distributed for 6th graders on Monday, September 11, 2023. Seventh and eighth graders are able to pick up their devices during Open House. Those who have not picked their device during Open House will be able to get them on this day, as well.

## **Cell Phone Expectations**

Students may bring their cell phones and personal electronic devices to school. Cell phones and personal electronic devices may be used before and after school. During the instructional day from 8:35 a.m. to 3:25 p.m., cell phones and personal electronics devices are to be put away and remain out of sight.

<u>Backpacks</u> Students will be allowed to carry their backpacks during the school day. PBIS lessons during the first few days of school will teach expectations.

## Middle School After School Program

Middle School After School is an after school club program provided by Mankato Area Public Schools' Community Education and Recreation Department, serving youth in grades 6-8. The program offers a variety of interest based clubs and a student union for academic support and recreational opportunities that promote personal growth and academic success. The after school program is available Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday at DMMS from 3:30 pm until 5:00 pm, and will begin on Monday, September 25th. Students meet each day in the cafeteria at 3:30 pm, and proceed to club activities from there. Fees are assigned to each club or student union opportunity. If you are in need of financial assistance, you may contact our office (507) 387-5501 for further information. Please note: you will need to provide transportation for your student, as this is **NOT PROVIDED** by the district. You **must register** for each day / activity you plan to attend MSAS. Clubs, fees, and schedule will change each quarter or as learning formats change during the 2023-2024 school year. For more information, please go online and visit www.mankatocer.com. Students may use Middle School After School as many days as their schedule allows. Registration fees are based on Quarter # 1 only and will be updated through the year.
