- I sing and make up my own silly songs.



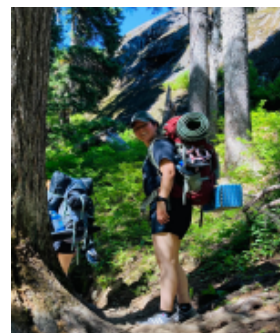
