Bussing information will be posted on August 28th and is updated right up until the first day of school. Please be patient and we will help you work through the process.

## First Days of School

The first few days of school are critical for establishing routines and expectations at Washington School.

#### <u>Arrival and Dismissal</u>

From arrival on the first day, we will set the expectations for the school community when transporting students to and from school. Our utmost priority is the safety of all students! If we all follow the set expectations, we will succeed at keeping everyone safe. Please obey the traffic rules and BE PATIENT! Cambridge Road is chaotic during these times of day.

Please be on time for dismissal and have an emergency contact available as a back up.

#### **School Expectations**

It is expected that students are respectful to other students, staff, and to themselves. We have a nurturing school community that fosters the growth of the whole student. It is just as much our job to help students grow socially and emotionally, as academically. We will spend the first few days establishing routines around the school and in the classrooms.

#### **School Supplies**

All standard school supplies will be provided to each student when they arrive to school on 9/6. Teachers may request additional items over the first week, including headphones for use in the classroom. Each student should come to school with a backpack, water bottle, and lunch (if not purchasing).

## Title I

We are pleased to announce that Washington Elementary School qualifies for Title I funding for the 2023-24 school year.

Title I programming provides resources and guidance to schools to ensure economically disadvantaged children receive a fair, equitable, and high-quality education, by helping to close academic achievement gaps.

Utilizing Title I funding, all students at WES will be begin the school year with the necessary school supplies. Keep a look out for future family night events sponsored through Title I funding.

All students will utilize a school provided device. These devices are an integral part of the learning process so proper care of them is necessary. It is strongly encouraged that all students purchase device insurance. More information will be sent home within the first few weeks of school. Help with devices and insurance is available at the Help Desk.


