CTK Senior Parking Permit Application 2023-2024

Regulations

1. Seniors may purchase a yearly parking permit for **\$35**. The cost to paint your spot is an additional **\$25**. (**\$60** total for a permit and painting.) We can only accept checks or cash. **IMPORTANT: You must have the exact amount of cash. We cannot give change.** (Make checks payable to CTK.)
2. Families needing more than one pass may purchase 2 passes for \$50. These passes may *not* be shared with or sold to anyone outside their immediate family. This is for families with multiple drivers. Students may drive more than one vehicle, but only need one pass. *Only Seniors may paint their parking spots.*
3. Please complete the required information below then sign *Acknowledgement of Parking Pass Regulations*; and return it to the Front Office with your check on **Tuesday, August 1st**.
4. Seniors may park in the **St. Joan of Arc Lot** (Upper Lot). This lot is for Seniors only.
5. You may *not* sell or give friends your parking permit. Violation of this policy will result in disciplinary action and/or loss of parking privileges.
6. Current 2023-2024 CTK Permits must be hung from your rear view mirror and be clearly displayed. Parking on campus without a clearly displayed current 2023-24 CTK parking permit is a violation of the parking regulations.
7. Parking in more than one spot is *not* permitted.
8. Parking in non-approved areas is *not* permitted. **Numbered spots are for faculty and staff only.** You may not park in designated visitor or handicap parking spots.
9. Irresponsible behavior (speeding, reckless driving, etc.) is not permitted and will result in disciplinary action and/or loss of parking privileges.
10. Infractions of these regulations will result in a discipline strike. On the third strike, you will receive a detention, your current permit will be revoked, and you will park in the St. Francis Xavier Lot (Gravel Lot) for an academic quarter. Further violations will result in permanent gravel parking. Certain actions may result in immediate removal of parking privileges.

CTK Senior Painting Guidelines 2023-2024

SGA is excited to offer this opportunity to reserve your parking spot and showcase your creativity. This is a Senior privilege. Please follow the guidelines below so we can successfully start a Senior parking/painting tradition at CTK.

1. All Senior parking applications will be due by **Aug 1**. You may turn in your signed application and money at the Front Office. (**\$60** total for permit and painting.) This is for ALL Seniors, whether you choose to paint your spot or not. You may pay by check, cash, or credit card. (Please make checks payable to CTK.)
2. **If you choose to paint your spot**, you must submit an image (hand drawn or electronically generated) on an 8 1/2 x 11 piece of unlined printer paper to be approved, along with your application on **Aug 1**.
3. Once the applications are processed and the images are approved, you will receive a randomly generated lottery number on **Aug 4**. **NOTE: This lottery number determines the order in which you will choose your spots. It does not correspond to a parking spot.**
4. An aerial view of the Senior parking spots will be uploaded to the Class of 2024 Google Classroom along with the list of Seniors in order of lottery number. You should discuss with your classmates which spots you would like and put comments into the Google Classroom doc.
5. At 8 AM on **Aug 9**, Seniors-only will begin choosing their parking spots from the image on Google Classroom in order of lottery number.
6. On **Aug 10**, from 8 AM - 3 PM, students will be able to paint their spots. Once the spot is painted, the image may *not* be added to or modified or altered in any way.

Important Notes:

- Seniors are responsible for providing their own paint
- Parking spot dimensions are 18 x 9 ft
- There will be a make up day for those unable to attend the **Aug 10** painting day
- Your image may not be in opposition to the Catholic faith or make controversial political statements or be overtly offensive to others.
- You may only paint the approved image. Any inappropriate images will be painted over and you will lose your upper parking lot spot.
- If any misconduct occurs during the painting day or if there is a refusal to cooperate with the guidelines, those involved will lose upper parking lot privileges for the first semester and/or be subject to additional consequences.
- If a student is not available to paint on Aug 10, an alternate date will be set up by Mrs. Milligan.
