Student, Teacher or Staff member with NO Known Exposure has a temperature $>100^{\circ}$ OR exhibits new or unusual symptoms of COVID-19:

Fever, chills • Shortness of breath • Sore throat • Loss of taste or smell • Headache • Loss of appetite • Cough • Nasal congestion • Nausea, vomiting or diarrhea • Fatigue • Muscle or body aches



REGARDLESS of vaccination status, individual must stay or return home and contact their health care provider.



Alternative Diagnosis:

Individual can return to school with a note signed by their health care provider explaining the alternate diagnosis.

**Alternative diagnosis must also be approved by school health office*



Negative COVID-19 test result:

Individuals can return to school if they present a copy of negative test result and are fever-free for 24 hours without fever reducing medications and other symptoms are improving.



Positive COVID-19 test result:

Individuals will be placed in isolation by the DOH and can return when they have met criteria for discharge and have been released from isolation by the DOH.



No Test/No Alternative Diagnosis:

Schools will monitor these individuals who will be allowed to return when they've met the following criteria:

At least 10 days have passed since start of symptoms

AND

Symptoms have improved

AND

Fever free for 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medications.
