On behalf of the Board of Education and our administrative staff, we extend our appreciation to our staff for their contributions to our very successful STEAM night events in each of our schools. She also reminded the audience that the Miller Place High School Panther Players productions of Mama Mia begins this weekend. Information regarding purchasing tickets for the performances are available via the District website.

Congratulations to our winter season athletics teams and competitors as our Wrestling team are League 6 champions which is their third title in four years with many individual champions, our independent swimming competitors won country championships in two events, a fencing independent competitor won county championship in foil, boys basketball reached the playoff competition, two girls track athletes qualified for state championships, along with relay team won the small school championship, boys track, one athlete qualified for state competition, Senior Thomas Cirritto was recently chosen as News12 Athlete of the Week and all six varsity teams achieved scholar athlete status.

The District is preparing for several upcoming events including watching the Robotics Team in their upcoming competition, Andrew Muller Primary School PARP week is March 2-6, Laddie A. Decker

Sound Beach School we are finalizing the logistics for the science show, art show and grade level family fun nights, North County Road Middle School character education programs are continuing with the support of our SIT Committee, and the Miller Place High School Virtual Enterprise class continues to impress with their organizations achievements in local and regional competitions.
