Dear Parent or Guardian,

For the 2023-2024 school year, the state of North Carolina requires specific immunizations for children entering Kindergarten and 7th grade. Parents/guardians must ensure that their child has received the immunizations at the age required by law within 30 days of the first day of school unless there is a written medical or religious exemption on file (General Statute 130A-152-157).

The required vaccines are listed below:

- *All students entering Kindergarten must have had two varicella vaccinations.*
- *All students entering 7th grade must have had one Tdap vaccination and one meningococcal vaccination.*

You should work with your child's doctor to get his/her immunization record or the vaccinations that are missing before the beginning of the 2023-2024 school year. If you are unable to get an immunization appointment with your child's health care provider, call your local health department for an immunization appointment. *Students failing to meet the requirements will not be allowed on school campus until immunizations have been updated.*
