

What is ADVISORY?



- Mondays and Wednesdays
- After 3rd hour
- Grades 11 & 12--go to Advisory 1st half, 2nd half lunch
- Grades 9 & 10-- Lunch 1st half, Advisory 2nd half
- ADV on Schedule is your advisory teacher/room
- Advisory is a grade level cohort you stay with until graduation
- College/career tasks, announcements, team building, AVID strategies/skills



- All 9th graders will be issued a locker
 - 10 -12 must request
- 9th graders will open locker on 9th grade first day of school
 - they will not be required to use lockers
- Locker information can be found in the Student Portal

How can I be successful in high school?


