



Vienna Parks & Recreation invites you to this trip to Glen Echo Park in Maryland. It was first developed in 1891 as a National Chautauqua Assembly which taught the sciences, arts, languages, and literature. It lasted for just one season, and by the early 1900s, the site had become Glen Echo Amusement Park–the premium amusement park serving the Washington area until 1968 when it closed.

Now the park is home to 13 resident artists and organizations, including two award-winning children's theaters, a nature and aquatic life program for kids, a thriving social dance program, a restored 1921 Dentzel carousel, numerous art studios and galleries, and hundreds of classes in visual and performing arts. You'll explore Glen Echo Park's history on a National Park Service tour and then enjoy lunch at the Irish Inn, which offers great food and atmosphere in a quaint setting. Lunch is included in the trip fee, which is \$78 for Vienna residents and \$97.50 for everyone else. All of this takes place on Wednesday, September 13 from 9:30 am-2:00 pm. 
