JOB DESCRIPTION

CAS Coordinator (International Baccalaureate) Position Overview: The CAS (Creativity, Activity, Service) Coordinator is a vital member of our International Baccalaureate (IB) team, responsible for overseeing and coordinating the CAS program for our students. The CAS Coordinator will play a key role in guiding students through their CAS experiences, ensuring compliance with IB regulations, and fostering a culture of personal growth and community engagement.

SPECIFIC DUTIES

- Monitor individual student progress, providing feedback, encouragement, and assistance when needed.
- Foster reflection and self-assessment among students to enhance their learning outcomes and personal development.

Documentation and Assessment:

- Establish an effective system for tracking and documenting students' CAS activities and reflections.
- Ensure accurate and timely submission of CAS documentation for IB evaluation and assessment.
- Collaborate with assessment coordinators to prepare students for the final CAS component of the IB Diploma Program.

- Experience working with the International Baccalaureate program, ideally in a CAS-related capacity.
- Strong understanding of the CAS program philosophy, objectives, and assessment requirements.
- Excellent organizational skills with the ability to manage multiple tasks and deadlines.
- Effective communication and interpersonal skills for working with students, parents, staff, and external partners.
- Empathetic and supportive approach to guiding students through personal growth and challenges.
- Collaborative mindset with the ability to work as part of a team and engage stakeholders effectively.
- Proficiency in documenting, tracking, and assessing student activities and progress.
- Enthusiasm for experiential learning, community engagement, and holistic education.
