PARENT PORTAL



Parents should ask to see this form on Tuesday night. It is important that every family reviews this information and sends corrections, as needed. We rely on cell phone numbers and email addresses. FIRST STUDENT BUS TRANSPORTATION

The bus routes are posted on the Hamden Public School's website.

Over 20 school buses transport our middle school students to HMS. Stop times are approximate; therefore, students should be at the stop 10 minutes before the posted times to avoid missing the bus. We strongly encourage you to have your child present at the stop early during the first week of school.

Students who ride buses home will be dismissed in the order buses arrive starting at 2:34 p.m.

We remind our students to be kind to their drivers, and we will review school expectations in the first weeks of school.

Next week, we will share school links and codes that can be used by families to participate in the First View bus tracking app. This allows families to know the location of their child's bus as it travels to and from school.

DROPPING OFF YOUR CHILD? PICKING UP YOUR CHILD? READ ON!

Many families choose to drive their children to school each day. We do our very best to ensure a safe morning arrival and afternoon dismissal. Please follow the routine and listen to staff directions. We ask parents to remain in a single lane around the bus loop. It is the best way to ensure student safety. Always pull up as far as you can go. Do not stop until you reach the stop sign. Students can be dropped off in front of the school. More parent cars in our lot equals less on Dixwell Avenue!

Here are some tips that might improve your experience:

- Members of the faculty and staff will report outside at 7:45 a.m. Students can exit their parent's car and stand under the portico until doors open.
- 2. Our dismissal begins at 2:34 p.m. This week, we will dismiss our students a little earlier. While this extra time seems to help, we cannot permanently follow this plan as it reduces instructional time during block 7.
- 3. If your child exits the car on Dixwell Avenue, please be sure they are leaving the car on the <u>right hand side of the vehicle</u>. Then, the child can

- walk down the grass and onto the sidewalk.
- Students should only cross
 Dixwell Avenue by the
 crosswalk. There is a
 crossing guard ready to help
 students safely cross the
 street.

We must work together to keep all of our children safe. If you choose to drive your child to school, be prepared for delays. Most importantly, we love seeing our parents! HMS CALENDAR MODIFICATION! Additional Early Dismissal Days

Hamden Middle School is actively participating in the Connecticut State Department of Education's Commissioner's Network. We intend to improve the overall educational experience for our students, as well as our climate and culture for all stakeholders. As part of the plan, our faculty and staff will participate in increased professional learning opportunities by adding the following early dismissal dates to the HMS calendar:

On these designated Mondays, our students will be dismissed at 12:05 p.m. Then, our teachers will participate in professional development aligned with the school improvement plan. It is important to note that these additional early dismissal dates are not referenced in the HPS calendars. They are unique to the HMS calendar. We are committed to communicating this information multiple times throughout the school year to ensure families are prepared for their middle school children to report home earlier. Finally, we will share updates on how we dedicate this additional professional learning time and the intended outcome on student learning.
