We are very excited to welcome new and returning students, families, and staff back for the 2023 -2024 school year at Stonington Middle School. We hope everyone enjoyed the summer and is now feeling refreshed and ready for school to begin. Everyone at SMS is enthusiastically awaiting our opening day on Tuesday, September 5th!

Our focus on building our school community by providing many opportunities for family involvement will continue this school year. We will be hosting multiple events for parents and guardians to learn more about their student's middle school experience, beginning with our Back to School Night Open House on September 20th. Our administrative and mental health teams will again be offering drop-in Q & A sessions for families at various times and sites in the community throughout the school year.

Our students are the most essential members of the school community. Helping students to understand the impact they can have on their classroom, school and local communities continues to be one of our main goals. In the first few weeks of school, students will learn about Rays' Way expectations at SMS and how being *ready*, *responsible* and *respectful* helps to create a safe, productive and fun learning community.
