<p><b>Definition of a Minor</b></p> <p>A minor means any person under the age of eighteen, except an individual who has received a high school diploma or a passing score on the general educational development examination.</p>	<p><b>Definition of a Minor</b></p> <p>Federal child labor rules only apply to individuals under the age of eighteen.</p>

### Exemptions

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<p>Certain exemptions from the law exist for:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Newspaper carriers</li> <li>• Actors, models, and performers</li> <li>• School work and supervised educational activities</li> <li>• Home chores</li> <li>• Work done for a parent or guardian</li> <li>• (unless the parent or guardian receives payment for the work)</li> </ul>	<p>Certain exemptions from the law exist for:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Newspaper carriers</li> <li>• Actors and performers</li> <li>• Youths engaged in making wreaths</li> <li>• Youths younger than 16 working in a business solely owned or operated by their parents</li> <li>• Agricultural employment</li> <li>• Apprentices and student-learners</li> </ul>
