FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

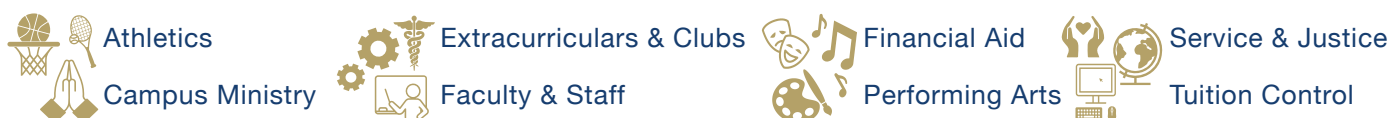
WHAT IS THE *MORE THAN FOUR* APPEAL?
