

APPLICATION OF BOARD POLICY MANUAL

The Colorado Springs School District 11 Board of Education (the Board) is responsible for developing and adopting policies to support the District's goals and the successful, efficient functioning of the District public schools. The Colorado Springs School District 11 (the District) Administration is responsible for developing administrative guidance in support of Board policies, in the form of regulations and exhibits. Board policies, along with accompanying regulations and exhibits, are collectively known as the Board Policy Manual.

The purpose of this policy is to establish that the Board Policy Manual applies regardless of whether work or instruction is taking place in an in-person, virtual, or remote manner. The foundations and basic commitments of the District apply in the various and alternative settings of learning and business operations.
