
*Resolved*, that we, the members of Colorado Springs School District 11 Board of Education, do hereby proclaim the week of April 24 – April 28, 2017, as:

Colorado Springs School District 11 encourages parents, students, teachers, and the entire district community to join us in recognizing and honoring these dedicated individuals.




