Subject: Safety Standards and Compliance

Management Directive #: MD- B2

Purpose:

To ensure compliance with the Colorado Springs School District 11 business plan by meeting the performance measurements of the safety related goal (Goal 5 – Provide a safe learning and working environment).

Directive:

District 11 is committed to providing a safe learning and working environment. All students, employees, volunteers, and visitors shall adhere to all district approved safety standards, first aid, occupational safety and health policies and procedures, and applicable state and federal safety and health requirements.

District 11 safety standards are developed primarily by the Safety Office and address area and topic specific programs, processes, and procedures. Compliance by all district staff at all locations is mandatory.

The state of Colorado requires compliance with numerous codes and regulations, to include the International Fire Code, unless a specific waiver or temporary exception is granted by the state or local authority having jurisdiction. Compliance with these codes and regulations is mandatory at all district locations.
