### **Testing Update (Brett Wiltz)**

- CMAS Testing is a go but still waiting on approval from State
- Proposal for required testing includes:
  - CMAS/CoAlt Math – 4<sup>th</sup> grade
  - CMAS/CoAlt ELA – 3<sup>rd</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grades
  - Optional parental opt-in for subjects not required (i.e. ELA – 4<sup>th</sup> grade; Math – 3<sup>rd</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grades)
- All certified teachers being trained for proctoring during week of March 29<sup>th</sup> – April 2<sup>nd</sup>
- CMAS Testing window is April 12<sup>th</sup> - April 30<sup>th</sup>

### **Restorative Justice Training (Brett Wiltz)**

- District 11 is placing a focus on Restorative Justice practices throughout the District
- Restorative Justice places emphasis on relationships with students and goes hand-in-hand with our CKH practices
- When behavior situations arise, focus is how we pull students back into the classroom environment and repairing of any wrong/harm that was done
- Brett is one of our few Restorative Justice Trainers in the District at this time
- Our STAR Supporters Team received initial Restorative Justice Training on March 8<sup>th</sup> and will be fully trained by the end of April

### **Fundraising Update (Angel Givler and Rachel Weldon)**

- Read-A-Thon
  - We raised \$8735.56 and will receive 80% for a total of \$6988.45

- Money will go towards technology, novels for classrooms, and MakerSpace area in our Library
- Online Book Fair
  - Raised over \$200
  - Money will go towards MakerSpace area in Library
    - Focus on collaborative, creative, innovative learning environment for our students
      - Lego wall
      - Gaming Club
      - 3-D Printing

### **CKH National Showcase Visit (Toni Schone)**

- We had our CKH National Showcase visit on March 18<sup>th</sup>
- Teams interviewed included parents, students, teachers, STAR Supporters team, and school administration
  - All groups had very positive things to share about our school
  - Family environment, relationships, great academic programs to include tutoring
- We should be notified of results by early May

### **Budget Allocation SY 2021-2022 (Toni Schone)**

- We received our SY 2021-2022 Budget Allocation
  - Instructional Account - \$43,660
  - Non-Instructional Account – \$10,645
- Funding is based on enrollment numbers
  - Projected enrollment this year is 462 students
  - Down 41 from last year’s projected enrollment of 503 students
- We hope to increase our enrollment which will also increase funding for our school
  - Enrollment Committee working on ideas to increase our enrollment post-pandemic

### **Upcoming Events (Toni Schone)**

- District 11 will become adopting the Purple STAR School Program which recognized schools who support their military families
  - We will be the first elementary school in the District to be recognized as a Purple STAR School
  - Military families look for this designation when choosing schools

- Training and supports will be provided to staff to help them better understand our military students
- Friday, April 16<sup>th</sup> has been designated by District 11 as “Purple Up Day” in honor of our military families – students and staff who wear purple on this day will have a free no-uniform day by showing their support
- Our teachers will be working on preparing for next school year in April and May
  - Scheduling Committee will develop a schedule for next school year
  - Teachers will be placing students into classes for next year
- McAuliffe will be hosting Summer School this year with more information to be coming soon
  - Dates: June 7<sup>th</sup> – July 2<sup>nd</sup>
