For our 100% remote students, we strongly encourage your best attendance, be an active participant, and communicate with your instructors when you have needs or questions. Please note, if you are a 100% remote student taking a college course with a lab, you will need to attend a weekly Monday AM or PM lab, per PPCC. Your instructor will reach out to you with details shortly.

Parents, a survey is being sent out soon, that will allow you to request to change your student's preferred learning method for the remainder of the year. Please be on the lookout.
