Juniors will not have to miss any of their concurrent enrollment courses due to the Saturday testing date. To help prep students for testing, SAGE Affordable Tutoring will be providing after school SAT test prep every Tuesday from 3:30 pm-5:00 pm in room 253, at no cost to D11 students through their testing date. Khan Academy is another personalized test prep tool that juniors can utilize. If you have any questions regarding SAT testing or are running into any issues, please reach out to Dr. Lamphere.


