



Concurrent Enrollment Application Frequently Asked Questions

1. What is the Concurrent Enrollment Application?

The Concurrent Enrollment Application is both an application to enroll in the concurrent enrollment program, as well as a promise to repay District 11 for any college classes that students fail or withdraw from. This document needs to be completed annually, for each student participating in college classes. Please read each section carefully to understand the policies, procedures, and expectations for concurrently enrolled students and their families.

2. What is the “Current Grade”?

You are completing this form for NEXT school year, so you should list the grade you will be next year.

3. What is my SASID?

The SASID is your State Student ID number. This is a separate number from your D11 number. It is OK to leave this section blank if you do not know you’re number, we will fill that in later for you.

4. How do I complete Section B: Post-Secondary Workforce Readiness?

The student’s plan of study is the career you would like to have or what degree you ultimately intend to pursue write it on the first line. (ex. Master’s Degree for Engineering, Bachelor’s Degree for Computer Science, Veterinarian, Lawyer, etc)

The student’s anticipated transfer school is the school that you think you would like to eventually go to. It is OK to leave this blank, if you do not know what college or university you want to attend.

5. How do I complete Section C: Qualifying Measures for College Placement?

This section will be completed by a School Counselor. You can leave this section blank.

6. What is Section D: Estimation of Cost Obligations?

This section shows the current tuition rates for PPCC classes. Classes taken at Odyssey cost \$17 per credit hour; classes taken at PPCC cost \$148.90 per credit hour. The majority of college classes are 3 credit hours each, so the chart shows how much money the district will pay for 3 credits (1 class), 6 credits (2 classes), and so on. These amounts are also the amount that your family would need to repay to the district if you fail or withdraw from a PPCC class or classes (this is further explained in Section F).

You and your parent need to initial the bottom indicating that you understand the tuition rates and the associated costs paid on your behalf.
