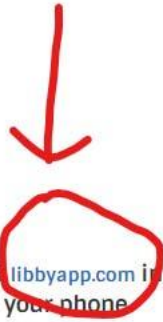


How to check out eBooks and eAudio from PPLD

Use the links in the Schoology Library course, or go to d11.org/rudy and click on the Library Media Center tab.



To read eBooks or listed to eAudio from PPLD, visit libbyapp.com in your web browser. Or, download the Libby App for your phone.

- You will need to choose Pikes Peak Library District (any branch) as your local library.
- Your PowerPass Library card number is your Short Network ID (just like for our school library)! Instead of using your password though, you have a PIN. Your PIN is your 4-digit birthday (two digits for the month and two digits for the date).

Your card number is your short network ID (First five letters of last name + first initial + middle initial + last four digits of your Student ID. It uses N for no middle initial.)

Your PIN is your 4-digit birthday (two digits for the month and two digits for the date). For example, April 15th would be 0415.
