The regular meeting was called to order at 6:00 by Casey in the library.

1. Introductions

2. Approve agenda

3. Approve minutes

March minutes approved.

4. Budget

The last page of the budget is confusing because the money amounts in the accounts has changed from previous months but it shows no money was spent. This includes Grant Student Support Services accounts and the Instructional Staff Training Accounts.

Some of the rollover money will be spent on the Family Consumer Science class.

The school found out before spring break they would have \$51,600 to spend on furniture. There is a need for new cafeteria tables. Twelve tables will cost \$34,552.76. The remaining money will be spent on student furniture, possibly flexible seating.

5. Master Schedule

A skeleton master schedule has been proposed for next year. Teachers prefer the team model. The proposed schedule allows a common planning time for teachers. There is also a dedicated tier 2 time for tutoring and exploration.

They will be building a virtual mock schedule in PowerSchool to see how it goes. First hour is 55 minutes, all other periods are 50 minutes.

7. Projected enrollment and teacher count for next year

Projected enrollment is down 29 students from current enrollment. The projection is 621 students. The teacher count for Sabin is down 2.8 teachers for next year. One teacher is retiring.

b) Custodians

4 positions available, \$2500 signing bonus.

c) Security Guards

Filled one position. Hoping to hire another candidate.

9. PTO Update

There is a parent interested in starting a PTO at Sabin. A survey was supposed to go out but none of the parents in our meeting had seen the handout. We also had issues with the link sent in the newsletter. Dr. Wiggins gave each of us the handout. Several parents are interested in helping get a PTA or PTO started.

10. Other Things

There was a question about how to access student report cards. Dr. Wiggins said he would include some information the newsletter.

The goal for next year is to have one parent involvement event per quarter.
