1. Introductions

a) Assistant Principal

Dr. Wiggins talked about some additional roll over funds that Sabin has. He is asking teachers what is needed. The family and consumer science class has immediate needs. Some money will be used for flexible seating.

There is remaining money (about \$18,000) from the Verizon grant that needs to be used on the maker space or recording studio. This needs to be decided by the end of the year,

Dr. Wiggins attended professional development on the 5 E data in preparation for the summer symposium. The date for One Plan development has not been finalized yet.

8. PowerSchool update

Power school was not bought. They continue to buy other companies to add into their product offering. The district has been affected because tools we currently use have not been integrated quickly enough (such as Hoonuit). PowerSchool has had to refund some money to district. The District is still committed to using PowerSchool.
