1) Introductions

- Lolly VanTeyligen Offutt, from Doherty High School PTA came to inform us about a Facebook grant they won at Doherty to present a Digital Community Event. The topics will be student led. Dinner will be provided. They are hoping for a good turnout where families of middle schoolers and high schoolers can have conversations about the digital community. She dropped off a poster.

Trait teams are currently part of advisory so we were wondering if these would be part of homeroom. Mr. Welch said they are still looking at changes to the Master Schedule. There is a meeting of the Master Schedule Team on

April 3. Having a homeroom is one of the options that the team has been looking at. Nothing is finalized. GMP looked at having advisory at the beginning and the end of each day. The new proposed master schedule will be proposed at the end of April.
