

In collaboration with William Jessup University (WJU), RCS offers students the opportunity to enroll in dual credit college courses.

Dual Credit allows a student to earn college credit through WJU simply by taking approved courses taught by RCS faculty. These Dual Credit courses provide a unique advantage, enabling students to earn both high school and college credits simultaneously. This participation empowers students to make significant strides toward their college goals while in high school.

Dual Credit courses offer a genuine academic experience with university-level semester grades. These grades are reflected on an official William Jessup University transcript. In addition, WJU credit is transferable to many colleges and universities nationwide, significantly enhancing a student's pursuit of higher education at WJU, or other institutions recognizing WJU credit.

- **Cost:** Students earn credit through WJU at \$70 per credit hour. A 3-credit hour course only costs \$210 for dual credit. The average cost per credit hour nationwide is currently \$456*, so this is a great value, potentially saving RCS families thousands of dollars in college tuition costs.
- **Eligibility:** To qualify, students must maintain a "C" grade (73% or better) each quarter and semester. Please understand that if students earn less than a 73% "C" any quarter or semester, they will not earn Dual Credit and all fees paid are not refundable.
- **Credit Recognition:** Dual Credit at RCS directly allows your student to accrue credit at WJU, a highly acclaimed, Christian University. In addition, WJU credit is widely accepted nationwide. *It is the students responsibility to confirm credit acceptance with their chosen institution's admissions department.*
- **Benefits:** Dual Enrollment College Courses offer a host of advantages, including low-cost education, time saved convenient on-site location, accelerated college progress, and improved graduation rates.
