IMPORTANT REMINDER - ATTENDANCE MATTERS

The first class of the day STARTS promptly at 7:40am. Students are welcome to arrive after 7am and breakfast is served starting at 7:15am.

We need EVERYONE'S cooperation to be here on time.

Students who understand the value of punctuality and attend school on time, **get better grades and enjoy a greater sense of well-being and confidence**

The school day ends at 2:40pm. Students should be off campus after 3:00pm unless they are under the direct supervision of a coach or sponsor.

Regular attendance is vital for student success.

- Your children can suffer academically if they miss 10 percent of the school year or about 18 days. That can be just one day every two weeks, and that can happen before you know it.
- Some absences are unavoidable. We understand that children will get sick and need to stay home occasionally. The important thing is to get your children to school as often as possible. Sporadic absences, not just those on consecutive days of school, matter. Before you know it just one or two days a month can add up to nearly 10 percent of the school year.
- If too many absences occur, it is still a problem whether they are excused or unexcused because they represent too much lost learning time in the classroom.

We appreciate our students, parents, staff and community helping to prioritize the importance of coming to school and then making sure to arrive on time to each class throughout the day.




PARKING PERMITS

The circled spots on the map are where students can park.


The X's indicate STAFF parking.



STUDENT SERVICES NEWS

Dear West Student and Families,

We are looking forward to see you all back in the building soon! This is a reminder that your schedule is available for you to see in your Skyward account. When you view your schedule, you'll be able to see both first semester (term 1 and term 2) and second semester (term 3 and term 4) classes.



All students had until May 31st last spring to change their minds on the courses they chose and to notify us so we could make adjustments. At this point in time we are only making changes for the following reasons:

- Student does not have a full schedule (7 classes each semester).
- Student is missing an ELA, math, social studies or science class.
- Schedule shows two classes in the same class period. Please note: Some classes have two teachers for the same class in the same classroom, and this is not an error.
- Student does not meet the prerequisite for a specific course.
- Schedule shows a course the student has already taken and the course cannot be repeated for credit (only art and PE courses may be repeated for credit).
- Student did not take a summer school course and needs the course added to schedule
- Student needs a specific course to meet graduation requirements.
- Student did not pass a course and needs to make up that credit.

• Schedule shows a course you did not request (either as a first choice or an alternate class).

Reminder: If you are enrolled in an AP or Honors course, you are committing to that course for at least the fall semester. We can consider changes for the second semester. Not completing required summer work does not qualify you for a schedule change.

FROM OUR SM WEST NURSE

Please remember to complete the Skyward Health History and Medication Permission forms for each student through Family Skyward. We need updated Over the Counter (OTC) medication permission each year to dispense these medications to your student.

Please contact the Nurse Office if your student has had any medical changes since last school year.

The SM West Nurse will be at Back-to-School night—on August 24th—if students/families would like to drop off any medications, vaccination records and/or discuss any health changes.

Vaccination Requirements

We must have verification of a **completed MCV/ACWY vaccine** (not meningitis B) for all Juniors by early October 2023. A dose after turning 16 years old is required, regardless of receiving this same vaccine in middle school.

In addition, all students will need a minimum of 1 (one) dose of Hepatitis A to start school.

If records are not received by the first exclusion date on October 23rd, 2023 students will not be permitted to attend school until verification is provided.

ICT Updates

We want to remind you of a few things now that we are back in the swing of the school year:

- 1. Your MacBook must have the district issued case on it at all times. (Failure to have the cover in place will result in confiscation of the MacBook.)
- 2. Please only carry your MacBook with the screen shut and with both hands to keep the machine secure.
- 3. Do not ever pick up the MacBook by the screen. The LCD is very sensitive and the pressure of your grip will break the screen.
- 4. Keyboard covers should not be used since non-Apple keyboard covers might be too large and can put pressure on the screens and cause damage.
- 5. Please don't leave your MacBook in a car overnight.
- 6. Needed programs can be found on Manager. You will not be able to download programs from the App Store for use on these devices.
- 7. Downloading VPNs (Virtual Private Networks) or other programs that mask your device on the network are a violation of the Responsible Use Policy you have agreed to. Use of these will result in the confiscation of the MacBook and you may MacBook access for the semester/school year for consistent violations.

- 8. Due to the MacBook refresh this summer and the cost of the new hardware, the replacement device cost has gone up. Although, the charger cost has dropped. The incident fees have stayed the same (fees reset in high school).
 - 1. 1st Incident/Damaged Device fee: \$100.00
 - 2. 2nd Incident/Damaged Device fee: \$150.00
 - 3. 3rd and Subsequent Incident/Damage Device fee: Actual cost of repair/replacement or \$300.00 whichever is greater.
 - 4. Apple MacBook Air M1 USB-C Cable Replacement \$19
 - 5. Apple MacBook Air M1 Charger Replacement \$39
 - 6. Apple MacBook Air M1 Adapter Set Replacement \$58
 - 7. Apple MacBook Air M1 Replacement/Lost Device fee \$1,117.95
- 9. If you ever need help or support with your device, please review our Tech Rescue Page (<u>https://sites.google.com/smsd.org/smwtechrescue/tech-issues</u>). If you are still experiencing issues, then you can submit a Web Help Desk Ticket (<u>https://support.smsd.org</u>).

Getting started with Canvas

#1 Accessing Canvas



Parents/Guardians can access Observer accounts to view grades, resources and activities posted in their child's courses. An account can be created within the app for mobile devices (iOS. Android) or via the URL https://smsd.instructure.com/login/canvas



If using the URL <u>click here</u>. If using the <u>Canvas</u>
<u>Parent App</u>, you will be asked to find your school.

Begin typing Shawnee Mission and select

parent/guardian. At the login page, select "parent of a canvas user- create account." Enter information and pairing code.

#2 Logging In

#3 Observer Accounts

Observer accounts can:

- View student grades
- Read announcements
- View the calendar
- See the course syllabus
- View list of assignments
- Set up email or text notifications

#4 Navigating the Courses

Students will have course cards for each subject area (math, science, reading, etc.). Each course card will contain resources, assignments, and other information important to that subject area.

As an observer, you have the option to set your preferences for how you'd like to receive notifications. Observers can receive an email, a push notification with the Canvas Parent app, or a text message when announcements are posted.

#6 Check Grades



Open the course>Click on "Grades"

This will access grades by assignment, overall grade and late or missing work. Canvas will have the most up to date grade, however, Skyward is still the official documented course grade that will be on a student's transcript. If Canvas and Skyward differ, and you have questions, reach out to your child's teacher.

#7 Message the Teacher



Parents can send a message to the teacher within a <u>Canvas course</u> or directly from an <u>assignment</u>.

#8 Use the Calendar



Click on the Calendar icon to view upcoming assignments in all courses, undated items and even add personal calendar events.

MESSAGE FROM FOOD SERVICE

Students are able to purchase breakfast and lunch prepared by our food service staff. Students may also bring sack lunches from home.

SM West does not allow for Door Dash deliveries or for fast food to be delivered to students during the school day.

ONLY SENIORS are allowed to leave campus for lunch - WITH Parent Permission. More information about this privilege will be communicated to seniors soon, but will not begin until potentially after Labor Day.

2023-24 - Child Nutrition Program Meal Benefit Application

Families are encouraged to complete an application for meal benefits – free or reduced priced meals – as part of the Online Verification. The link to the Child Nutrition Program Meal Benefit Application is available on Skyward or the online application is on School Cafe. Families do need to create a School Cafe account if they do not already have one - more information may be located on the SMSD Food Service Free and Reduced web page. Contact the Food Service office by calling 913-993-9710 for questions on the meal benefit application.

Potential Benefits of Filling out the Application

Families, whose meal benefit application is approved for meal benefits, can receive a breakfast and lunch at the free or reduced price – depending on their qualifying benefit.

Families who complete an application and qualify also generate additional state funds for our schools.

Families who qualify for child nutrition meal benefits, may receive additional benefits such as free/reduced instructional resource fees, transportation fees, and Pre-k enrollment.

Consent for Disclosure and Eligibility

Families are encouraged to complete a Consent for Disclosure form in Skyward which gives SMSD Food Service permission to share a child's eligibility status information with the programs families designate on the consent form.

Families who are receiving certain types of state assistance, a meal benefit application may not be necessary. If a family is directly certified for meal benefits due to state assistance, Food Service will email a notification of eligibility. If you receive state assistance and have not received a notification of eligibility, call the SMSD Food Service office before completing a meal program application.

Families who are directly certified are encouraged to complete a Consent for Disclosure form in Skyward which gives SMSD Food Service permission to share a child's eligibility status information with the programs families designate on the consent form.



- Payments can be made multiple ways.
 - Send a check or cash to the school with the student marked as lunch money
 - Pay online via eFunds Choose Pay for Optional Fees to add funds to meal accounts
 - Pay by phone by calling Food Service office 7am to 4pm 913-993-9710
- Students will be served a reimbursable meal whether the meal account balance is positive or negative
- Ala carte options are available but varies per school level. Students will not be permitted to purchase ala carte items if their account is negative.

TRANSPORTATION UPDATE

ALL Students must be registered with DS Bus Lines in order to ride the bus.

Please note the following important information for 2023-24 busing:

- Bus registration may be found at the following link: <u>DS Bus</u>
 <u>Lines registration</u>
- 2023-24 bus fees will remain the same as the prior year.
 - \$185/semester/student or \$370/year/student
- Any student attending their home school and living 2.5 miles or more from the school qualifies for free busing. Registration is required.
- Students who qualify for the Child Nutrition Meal Benefits free and reduced priced
 meals may also qualify for free transportation, and enroll to ride existing routes. When
 registering, please provide a copy of the Child Nutrition Meal Benefits Eligibility letter to
 DS Bus Lines to complete the enrollment process. SMSD families can apply for Child
 Nutrition Meal Benefits after July 1st on School Café
 - https://www.schoolcafe.com/SHAWNEEMISSION.
- Transportation changes put in effect during the 2022-23 school year will remain in effect for the 2023-24 school year. This includes limiting high school routes to students residing over 2.0 miles from their school.
- Bus routes and stop locations will be determined based on those who register for busing. A minimum number of registrations (50 paid) is required in order to offer a route.
- Annual transportation registration is required for students to receive bus service.





