
# HOSA International Leadership Conference in Dallas, Texas












### FENTANYL: THE FACTS 💮 🎇





#### THERE IS NO SUCH THING AS A SAFE STREET DRUG.

Teenage overdose deaths from synthetic opioids like fentanyl have tripled in the last two years. Fentanyl is odorless and tasteless, making it easier to hide in other substances.

WHAT IS FENTANYL? Fentanyl is a very strong narcotic pain medication that is prescribed for severe, disabling pain and pain after surgery. Fentanyl acts on the brain and central nervous system like other opioids such as morphine and heroin. Fentanyl is about 100 times stronger than morphine, therefore it is very easy to overdose on this drug. Fentanyl acts very quickly inside the body and this fast action can cause you to stop breathing much quicker than other drugs and therefore has a much greater chance of overdose.

### SIGNS OF OVERDOSE.

#### WHICH IS A LIFE-THREATENING EMERGENCY. INCLUDING THE FOLLOWING:


- The face is extremely pale and/or clammy to the touch.
- The body is limp.
- Fingernails or lips have a blue or purple cast.
- The person is vomiting or making gurgling noises.
- The person cannot be awakened from sleep or cannot speak
- Breathing is very slow or stopped.
- The heartbeat is very slow or stopped.

- Never take a random pill I will only take pills prescribed to me by my own doctor.
- Spread the word I will tell my friends who may be experimenting, recreationally using or struggling with substances about the dangers of fake pills.
- Find alternatives I will explore healthier ways to cope with my pain, stress or anxiety,
- Be available I will be honest with myself and supportive of others when speaking of
