

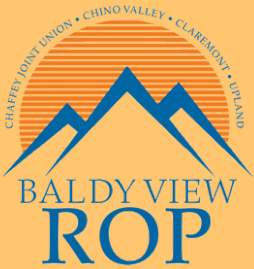

Sonja is the 2023 President of the Board of Education, and will represent the District as city of Chino liaison, and representative to the Baldy View Regional Occupational Program Commission.

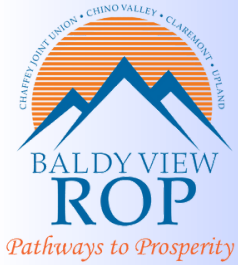


Commission Member

CLAREMONT



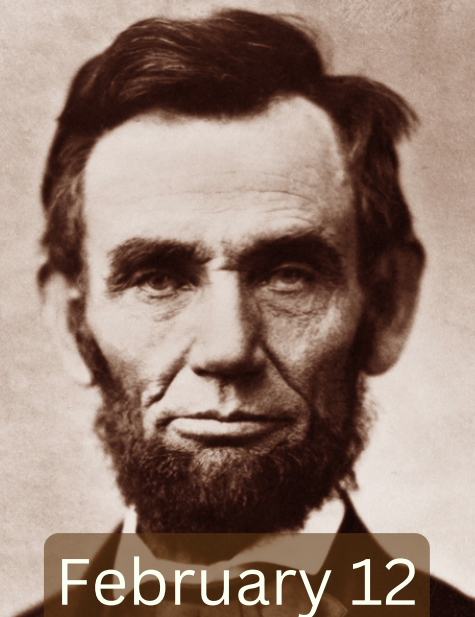
