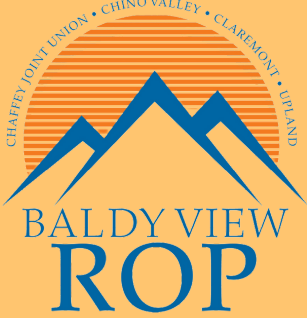

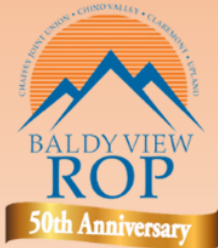

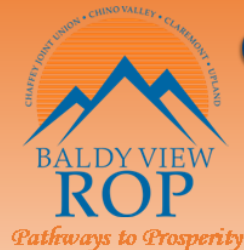

CHAFFEY JOINT

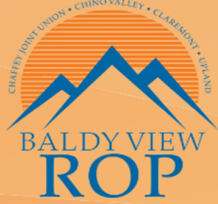

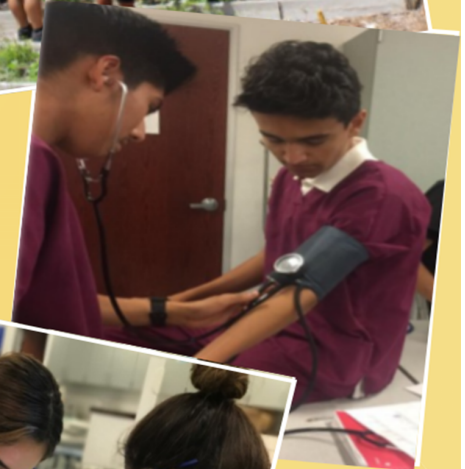

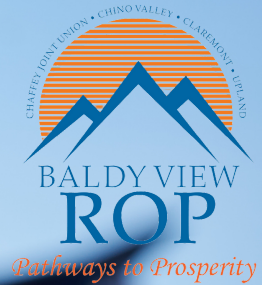

UPLAND

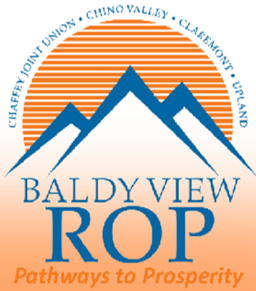

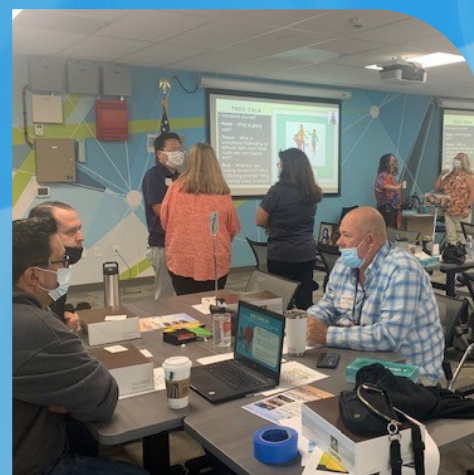
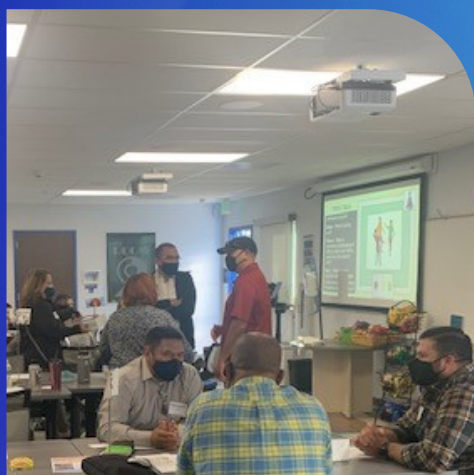


OCTOBER PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

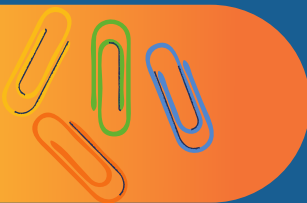

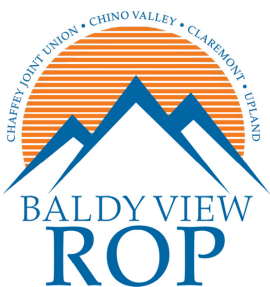
GEORGE LEE
