#### Criminal Justice Instructor

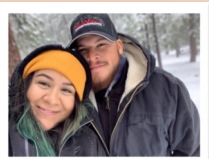

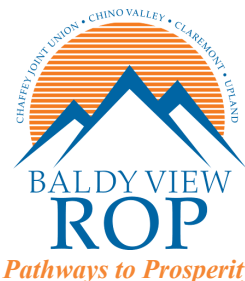
