

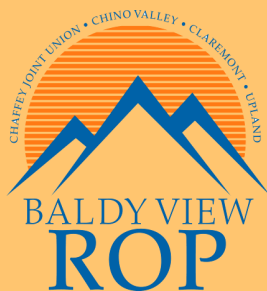

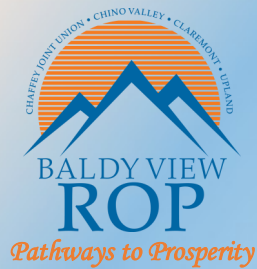

Upland



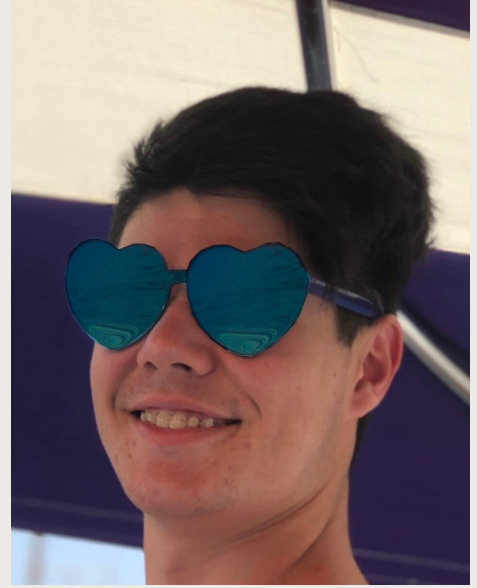
