




Chino Valley

Dear Baldy View ROP Stakeholder:

Gov. Gavin Newsom and Tony Thurmond, state superintendent of Public Instruction, have called upon school districts across the state to remain closed through the remainder of the 2019-20 academic year, while continuing the education of all students through distance learning.

Baldy View ROP, in collaboration with all 33 school districts in San Bernardino County and the 2 JPA ROPs, as well as the county superintendent and the county Department of Public Health, has made the decision to put the safety of students and staff foremost and extend the closures of our schools for the remainder of the school year.

It is out of an abundance of caution that our public school agency is making this difficult decision to help stop the spread of the novel coronavirus – or COVID-19. This decision to extend the closure of our school sites comes during unprecedented times as we look to support our communities in following protocols and guidance for physical distancing. Despite the closing of our school sites, education of our students must continue and acknowledgment of our students' accomplishments will continue.

Our remarkably talented instructors, classified support staff, and administrators remain committed to providing the students of Chaffey Joint Union High School District, Chino Valley Unified, Claremont Unified, and Upland Unified School Districts with relevant learning of career technical education through distance learning via online platforms.

We are continuing to work with the state Department of Education, state board agencies, and our partnering school districts to provide guidance on grading, graduation, college and career readiness, and state board certifications. 


