










Baldy View ROP by the Numbers 2019-2020

Fire Technology




Fire Technology students practice fire hose skills and provide demonstrations at Career Training Center.



In the late 90s, Fire Captain Yvan Fuentes from the Ontario Fire Department took two ROP classes- Fire Technology and Emergency Medical Responder (EMT) at Upland High School. Captain Fuentes shared that ROP allowed him to make life-long friendships. Captain Fuentes utilized the experience and certifications he gained from his ROP courses to work as an EMT immediately after graduation and joined the Ontario Fire Department Explorers. His ROP foundational skills enabled Captain Fuentes to register for Paramedic school. With his career continuing to expand, Captain Fuentes was hired and worked in fire service for 15 years. Captain Fuentes encourages students to "invest in YOURSELF, study, train, and seek positive guidance. By investing in yourself today, it will pay off in the future." Fire Captain Fuentes holds the position of Advisor to Fire Explorers, is a Fire Academy instructor at Mt. SAC, and an EMT instructor at La Puente Valley ROP. 






CONNECT WITH US!
