

Sierra Aviation Group was founded in February 1997 as an airline service provider at San Diego Airport. The Airport had experienced a terrible holiday season with an under-performing luggage delivery service. Working in the industry and hearing the horror stories of failed deliveries, Jim Mog saw an opportunity and formed Sierra Aviation. Mr. Mog's 14 years of experience as the Station Manager for America West Airlines in

multiple cities through-out the country offered him experience and insight in the areas of airline and airport services. Within 2 months, Sierra Aviation began baggage delivery at San Diego Airport.

Shortly after, Mr. Mog was once again being called upon to transfer to the eighth city of his airline career. Tired of constant moving, he chose Southern California to call home and left the airline industry to focus on his own business. He brought Sierra Aviation's service to the Ontario Airport in July of 1997. It increased its service to include skycaps, wheelchair runners, and janitorial services for not only the airlines but for the Ontario airport as well.

Years later, tragedy struck on September 11, 2001, changing the commercial travel industry forever. New security measures and policies were being implemented and the airline industry was reeling to keep up. Sierra Aviation took on ever-increasing roles by cross training Ontario Airport employees to provide new security services. At Ontario Airport, Sierra was adding employees and tripled the size of staff within 6 months. This demand of time forced Mr. Mog to make the decision to voluntarily stop service at San Diego Airport and devote his full attention to the Ontario location. After several years, Sierra expanded service to Palm Springs Airport in November of 2003 and Orange County Airport in September of 2004. Currently, Sierra Aviation employs approximately 180 employees at all 3 locations.

A few years later Sierra Aviation was given yet another amazing opportunity. In 2006, Sierra Aviation was presented with the opportunity to give back to its community through mentoring students taking the Baldy View ROP Airport Careers course. Students are trained in customer

service and other workforce skills. This eventually brought about the Leadership and Management Program through Sierra Aviation Group. Students were given management training in problem solving, time management, human resources, scheduling, and various technical and inter-personal skills. A certificate for Leadership and Management was created for students who completed the course and who demonstrated exemplary skills.

Today, 1 in 3 new hires for Sierra Aviation's work force got their start with Sierra Aviation through their coursework with Baldy View ROP.

Jim Mog shared, "We are proud to be a partner with ROP and look forward to many more years of continued service. Through the Career Technical Education Incentive Grant (CTEIG), Baldy View ROP has made major updates to the Registered Dental Assistant (RDA) lab. Walking into class on Monday, March 13, RDA



students were greeted with brand new state of the art equipment! Changes included switching from analog to digital radiography & photography equipment, sterilization equipment, chairs & delivery units, panoramic digital X-ray machine, and a newly equipped computer lab. The updates provide students with increased access to industry standard technology ensuring our students are equipped with 21st century training! The public had a chance to see what the new RDA simulation lab has to offer and learn about the course when they attended the RDA Information Night and Open House on April 21<sup>st</sup>. ## **Baldy View ROP Meets with State Congressional Members in Sacramento**

Superintendent Shelley Adams and Assistant Superintendent of Educational Services Dr. Forest DeRenzo attended the CAROCP Board & Legislative Forum March 13 - 14, 2017 in Sacramento, California. Superintendents and CTE leaders present at the forum lobbied for sustainable funding for the California CTE College and Career Indicator Dashboard. The dashboard collected data from 2015-2016 among 50,000 students enrolled in CTE courses last school year. Baldy View ROP is one of 11 piloted CTE sites participating in the dashboard. Baldy View ROP's presence at the forum allowed us to share with legislators our current student data and placement, and helps ensure funding for continued research. Funding for the CTE College and Career Indicator Dashboard would

expand the scope of data to include work-based learning and post-secondary placement through 2018. Data collected provides insight into students' education as well as the job market they are preparing to enter. This information also assists Baldy View ROP in creating courses and curriculum to help students succeed.


