HISTORY

The Baldy View ROP is a California public school agency that provides career preparation programs and services. It was established in November of 1972 and is now operating under a joint powers agreement between the Chaffey Joint Union High School, Chino Valley Unified, Claremont Unified, and Upland Unified School Districts.

The ROP is part of a statewide network of 73 regional occupational centers and programs which began to develop in 1967. Statewide, more than 450,000 students enroll annually in ROP courses to better prepare themselves for the world of work and advanced training.

The Baldy View ROP is accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges.
