Goals and Objectives

It shall be the policy of the Baldy View Regional Occupational Program (ROP) to:

1. Believe all students need to meet high standards of career technical education and academic knowledge and skills.
2. Believe all students must have the ability to apply their skills to the workplace where they will be required to adapt to emerging technologies and changing societal needs.
3. Provide an integrated career technical education program that provides students with:
 - A. the ability to analyze, think creatively, solve problems, make decisions, and apply knowledge and skills to real-life situations
 - B. strong communication and interpersonal skills
 - C. experience with a variety of technologies
 - D. a flexible personal career plan based on:
 - (1) awareness of possible career paths
 - (2) career counseling
 - (3) consecutive work-site learning experiences
 - (4) an understanding of all aspects of the industry the student is preparing to enter
 - E. Specialized skills that can lead to career entry level positions or more advanced training, certification, and/or education.
 - F. Respect for a diversity of cultures and thoughts.
 - G. A positive work ethic and ability to work independently or in a team
 - H. The ability to seek out, organize, and learn new information
