

COMMUNITY AND BUSINESS PARTNERS

1. Encourage people who are especially qualified because of training, experience, or personal characteristics to take an active part in Baldy View Regional Occupational Program (ROP) affairs.
2. Invite such persons to act as advisers individually and in groups in areas such as the following:
 - a. Clarification of general ideas and attitudes held by residents in regard to the programs offered by the ROP.
 - b. Development of broad policies under which the JPA consortium is to be managed.
 - c. Establishment of administrative regulations designed to implement these policies.
 - d. Determination and evaluation of courses of study and special services to be provided for students.
 - e. Give active assistance to the professional staff in the actual operation of classes and services where the staff deems such aid valuable.
 - f. Solve a specific problem or set of closely related problems about which a decision must be made.
3. Direct the Baldy View Regional Occupational Program Commission and ROP staff to give substantial weight to the advice received from individuals and community groups while maintaining their own best judgment in arriving at decisions.
