#### Please read the following rules:

- 1. I will abide by the pool rules hanging at the pool and have read the lap lane etiquette rules included in this registration form.
- 2. I understand I need to pay in full at the time I start my session.
- 3. I understand that lap-swimming privileges are nontransferable.
- 4. I understand that the pool facilities may close for various reasons including bad weather and that I need to check my email *before* traveling to Pennington each day for possible last minute cancelations. I understand that I must leave the facility by 9:15 a.m. Showers are closed at this time. Bathrooms are available.
- 5. I understand that participation in lap-swimming happens only during the scheduled time for lap-swimming unless otherwise communicated from the Director of Aquatics.
- 6. I understand that Pennington strongly encourages visitors to be vaccinated and that it is optional to wear a mask on deck and in the building.

In case of emergency I agree to be treated by a lifeguard, licensed physician, or hospital. Furthermore, I hereby agree to completely and unconditionally indemnify, save harmless, release and discharge The Pennington School, its employees and volunteers from all liabilities, including exposure to Covid-19 and all viral variants that results in sickness, or other injuries sustained by participating in this program.



Please leave the bleachers open and use the white benches for sitting.

We ask all swimmers to be out of the building by 9:15 a.m.

Please check your email each morning \*before leaving for lap swim\* in the event of a last minute cancelation due to weather.
