Baldy View ROP receives California Department of Education CTE Incentive Grant

Baldy View ROP was among 669 local educational agencies in California to be awarded part of the \$245 million in career technical education (CTE) grants through the State's CTE Incentive Grant program. Baldy View ROP applied for the grant as a consortium comprised of committee members from its partnering districts of Chaffey Joint Union High School District, Chino Valley, Claremont, and Upland Unified School Districts. Among the consortia selected for grants, Baldy View ROP received one of the largest awarded of \$6.8 million.

The CTE Incentive Grant was designed to encourage school districts to partner with colleges and business, as well as to support the emergence of new and developing CTE programs. Consortia receiving grants will have to prove their effectiveness through 10 criteria including curriculum and instruction aligned with California CTE standards, course-completion rates, and the number of students receiving certificates and industry certifications through these courses.

Baldy View ROP will use the grant funding primarily for its courses in the medical, informatics, and logistics fields, each of which are industries that offer high-employment opportunities in the Inland Empire region.
